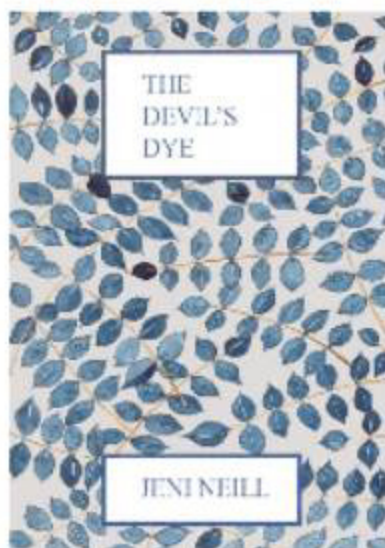


FRIENDS OF DISS MUSEUM
